Do you have project management experience at a senior level?</p> <p>'Observe AHP' is an exciting and novel project, an alternative to work experience for aspiring Allied Health Professionals (AHPs) aged 16 and over. It is a FREE, interactive video platform which provides insights into the role of an AHP in the primary care sector. The project aims to produce five work experience career films and other resources to supplement the platform's content, mirroring that available on the successful 'Observe GP' platform (LINK: <a href="https://www.rcgp.org.uk/your-career/work-experience/observe-gp">https://www.rcgp.org.uk/your-career/work-experience/observe-gp</a>).</p> <p>This role is suitable for an individual (clinical AHP or non-clinical staff) wishing to further develop their professional project management skills at a senior level. The successful applicant should be currently working in BNSSG general practice and will be employed via a Fellowship (whilst retaining their substantive role).</p> <p>This role will work with BNSSG Training Hub's Advanced Practice Lead to manage the 'Observe AHP' project and take responsibility for its accurate definition, communication, resourcing, delivery, reporting, and evaluation. This is a fixed-term post (for 12 months - at Agenda for Change Band 6), which will join and support our growing, busy, and friendly Training Hub team.</p> <p>As the primary care workforce expands, there is a need to ensure that the wider public are aware of the multi-professional roles now working in the sector. These include First Contact Practitioners</p>			



(FCPs) and Advanced Practice (AP) roles, which provide opportunities as future career pathways for AHPs.

The five work experience career films and other resources will reflect the work of AHPs in primary care (including MSK Physiotherapists / Occupational Therapists (OTs) / Dietitians / Paramedics / Podiatrists).

Our aim with this role is:

- To expand the existing RCGP Observe GP offer to include the wider workforce in primary care
- To promote diversity and inclusion of AHPs in primary care career campaigns
- To take targeted intervention, aligned to the widening participation agenda
